Dr Ashok Sethi BDS



Dr Ashok Sethi BDS Ncle 1974; DGDP(UK) 1992; MGDSRCS Eng. 1993; DUI Lille 1998, qualified from the University of Newcastle upon Tyne and is a specialist in Oral surgery as well as Prosthodontics.

Since 1979, Ashok has pioneered and refined, both in the UK and Internationally, the art and science of surgical and restorative implant dentistry. His practice is totally dedicated to implants, achieving outstanding success rates in terms of predictability as well as aesthetic and functional outcome. He is a Fellow and Diplomate of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists and has a Diploma in Advanced Implantology from the University of Lille. He is a founding member and past Chairman of the Association of Dental Implantology and is the director of the Diploma in Implant Dentistry organised by the Faculty of General Dental Practitioners (UK) at the Royal College of Surgeons of England.

Ashok has been invited to speak at scientific meetings around the world. He has organised and taught on postgraduate courses accrediting dentists in Implant dentistry in the UK and Europe. He has published significant data in professional and scientific journals on fundamental and advanced techniques in Implant Dentistry. He has recently written (with Thomas Kaus) a book "Practical Implant Dentistry", which has been translated into 10 languages

Prof Peet van der Vyver

Prof Peet van der Vyver qualified as a dentist BChD (Cum Laude) at the University of Pretoria in 1992. In 2007 he completed a Diploma in Endodontics (Cum Laude), Masters Degree in Endodontics (Cum Laude) and a Diploma in Aesthetic Dentistry (Cum Laude). A private practitioner based in Johannesburg, he is a member of SADA, IADR, NOMADS, Study Group 1, Endodontic Society of South Africa, Dental Materials Group and the Academy for Microscope Enhanced Dentistry. He is a part-time lecturer in the Department of Odontology, University of Pretoria. In January 2008 he was appointed as an Extraordinary Professor in the Department of Odontology. Peet is currently the President of the Endodontic Society of South Africa, Nomads and The South African Academy of Aesthetic dentistry (SAAAD). At the 1993, 2000 and 2001 IADR congresses he won the Hugo Retief Award for research in Dental Materials, and was the recipient of the 1996 and 1997 Floyd Memorial Award for the best scientific papers published in the Journal of the Dental Association of South Africa. Prof van der Vyver has over 167 publications to his credit, lectured extensively and has organized and presented numerous dental courses, lectures and hands-on symposia at national and international congresses. Endodontics and bonded restorations accounts for a significant percentage of Prof van der Vyver's practice and he is eager to share his passion and knowledge about these subjects with those who attend his lectures. In his limited spare time he enjoys photography.

Prof Verma is involved in research in the field of Prosthodontics and Dental Materials, Implants and other Dental Sciences. He has received numerous awards for excellence in his field.

Sudeshni Naidoo is a Professor and Principal Specialist in Community Oral Health, and is currently the Deputy Dean for Postgraduate Studies and Research at the Faculty of Dentistry at the University of the Western Cape, having previously held the posts of Principal Dentist, Dental Researcher at the Medical Research Council and Senior Registrar in Community Dentistry. She is presently the Director of the WHO Collaborating Centre for Oral Health.

She received her BDS (Lon) and LDS.RCS (Eng) in 1985 and Masters in Dental Public Health (MDPH) at the University of London and the Diploma in Dental Public Health (DDPH) in 1994 from the Royal College of Surgeons of England, followed by her specialist MChD degree in Community Dentistry in 1999.

She is involved in post-graduate education and training and her main focus of research is on Infectious Diseases and Infection Control, with particular reference to HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis and TB, and a specific focus on health education and health promotion; ethics and bioethics; the disadvantaged with regard to provision of Oral Health Care, Oral Health Quality of Life, Trauma and Child Abuse. She has written HIV/AIDS policies, Hepatitis B vaccination policy for the Provincial Administration of the Western Cape, published and presented on Child Abuse, Cross infection, Hepatitis and HIV/AIDS.

Raj RajaRayan is a British Tamil. He was educated at Harrow School, Guys and the Eastman. He was awarded the Order of the Officer of the British Empire by The Queen for services to Dental Education. He subsequently became the first black Dean at the Royal College of Surgeons of England. He was an elected member of the General Dental Council for many years, a Member of the Advisory Committee to the Secretary of State for Health and a member of the Lord Chancellors Judicial Appointments Committee. He lectures extensively internationally and is the Associate Dean for Postgraduate Dentistry at the London Deanery.

Dr Wyman Chan, BDS; LDS,RCS qualified at Guy's Hospital Dental School, London, UK, in 1981. He is the founder of Smile Studio Teeth Whitening Academy and has trained over 2000 dentists, dental hygienists, dental therapists, dental surgery assistants and other dental team members in the past eight years in his Academy. As a dedicated teeth whitening dentist, Wyman has worked with all major home and power whitening systems in the past twenty years. His innovative research in the field led to five UK granted patents on bleaching gel formulation, bleaching devices and methods of bleaching. Through his unique combination of research and wet handed experience on 1000's of patients, Wyman has discovered some major important phenomena in the texture of teeth. Using these findings he developed some important protocols and metrics that improve our understanding of the safety, predictability and efficacy of teeth whitening processes. He has published many articles including a chapter in the newly published Quintessence book – The Art of Treatment Planning – and is widely regarded as an expert in this field. He lectures internationally and runs regular hands-on power whitening seminars in London.
